Major collections in most areas of the Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences are held in the **Berkeley/Lecky/ Ussher** Library. The **Hamilton** Library contains collections in Science, Engineering, Technology and Pre-Clinical Medicine. The **John Stearne Library** at St. James's Hospital houses Clinical, Medicine, Surgery, Nutrition, Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy.

The **Old Library** houses the Departments of Early Printed Books and Manuscripts. The EPB collections include over 300,000 works printed before 1901. Major strengths are in Irish and English printed books of all periods, Reformation pamphlets and 17th and 18th century French and Dutch books. Subjects covered in dept include Drama, Literature, Religion, Medicine and Science and there is an important collection of pre 1840 maps. The manuscript collections contain the College muniments, medieval manuscripts and a range of literary papers from Irish writers.
