# Calculus Course for Leaving Certificate Students delivered by Professor Tony Dorlas

- Students wishing to enrol on this course must provide a letter of recommendation from their mathematics teachers as to their suitability for the course. They must also complete the attached registration form. Where the student is under 18 years of age, the registration form has to be signed by a parent/guardian. (The letter of recommendation, registration form and course fee are required by 25<sup>th</sup> September)
- The course fee will be €40 which must be paid in advance by 25<sup>th</sup> September. Payment can be made online on the DIAS Payments website (http://payments.dias.ie) or by cheque (cheque made payable to "Dublin Institute for Advanced Studies").
- Classes will run for 2 hours and will take place at No. 10 Burlington Road, Dublin 4. Depending on numbers, it may be necessary to run a morning and afternoon class. In that case there would be a morning class from 10.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and an afternoon class from 2.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. Students are asked to indicate on the form if they have a preference for morning/afternoon. Every effort will be made to accommodate the preferred option of students but there is no guarantee that we will be able to do so. In the event that the number of applicants only require one class, a decision on its time will depend on the preferences made by the applicants. The course will run for a term of ten weeks commencing on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2016. There will be no class on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> November, meaning the ten-week term will finish on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2016.
- The course will be delivered by Professor Tony Dorlas, Senior Professor at DIAS.
- Regular attendance will be compulsory as well as completion of the exercises. Students will be required to sign in for each class and should advise us in advance if they are unable to attend any of the classes. A certificate of attendance will be provided at the completion of the course.
- Classes will run for 2 hours. There will be a short 10/15 minute break. Please note that there are no vending machines or facilities for getting food/drinks so students would have to bring their own snacks/refreshments if required.
- Students should bring two notebooks and an A4 graph copybook.
