Location Photography and Filming

The Dublin Institute for Advanced Studies (DIAS) encompasses four locations across Dublin:

- 10 Burlington Road, Dublin 4, D04 C932;
- 31 Fitzwilliam Place, Dublin 2, D02 XF86;
- 5 Merrion Square North, Dublin 2, D02 Y006; and
- Dunsink Observatory, Castleknock, Dublin 15, D15 XR2R.

Permission for photography and/or filming at any of these locations must be obtained in advance from the office of the CEO & Registrar. Anyone applying for permission they should outline the purpose of the filming / photography. DIAS reserves the right to refuse permission.

Any film or photography footage taken at any of DIAS' locations must credit DIAS in the film and/or photo credit or caption. The aims and content of the work being produced must be consistent with the aims, strategy and mission of DIAS, be consistent with the status of Dunsink as a national heritage site, and should present Dunsink and DIAS in a positive light.
